Church Facility

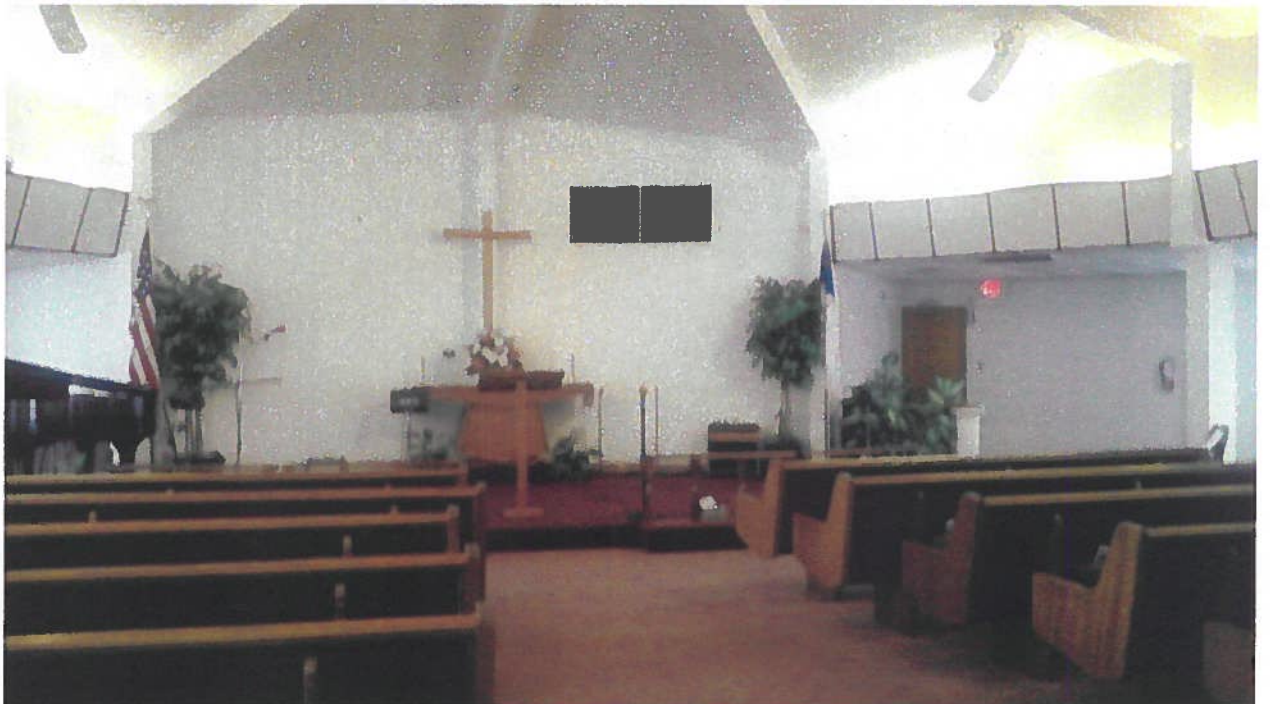
The church sanctuary was built in 1972 as part of the Disciples of Christ organization. In 1994 the congregation voted to secede from that organization and become an independent church. In 2007 the congregation voted to join the Open Bible Family and proudly remains there today.

The footprint consists of three main buildings. The sanctuary is 3000 sq. ft. with a seating capacity of 80-100 worshipers. An adjoining new structure built in 2008 consisting of 3000 sq. ft. with an entry foyer, nursery, church office, pastor's office and bathroom facilities. A fellowship hall was built in 1982 with a total of 2500 sq. ft. including a large gathering room, full kitchen, three meeting rooms and a bathroom. All church facilities are co-located on a four acre tract of land with ample parking for all services and special events. The church is located in Seminole Florida.

Financial

Due to the current congregation size initial compensation will be inadequate to meet the needs of a full time pastor. Therefore, a bi-vocational pastor would be ideal at this time. Not including pastoral compensation the present annual operating budget is \$63,000 with a fiscal year of January to December. With promising growth potential the pastoral compensation package can be upgraded over time.

Community

The church is located just four miles from the sunny beaches of the Gulf of Mexico with miles of public beach access with numerous shopping and dining venues, from mom and pop shops to upscale name brand shopping or from a quick meal to some of the area's best gourmet restaurants. Numerous sports teams call the Tampa Bay area home, as well as spring training complexes.

As far as local municipalities, Seminole and Largo have had an average population growth of 58% and 12% respectively since 2000. In addition, some 381,000 jobs have been added in the Pinellas County area. Median family income is around \$56,000. Within a five mile radius of Seminole Christian Fellowship the primary construction is single family homes 67 % followed by apartments and condominiums.

Additionally located within four miles of the church are excellent elementary, middle and high schools, college campuses and public library facilities. We are also blessed with two Christian schools within similar distances.

Recreation centers and numerous county parks with open access are within five miles of the church.

There are multiple excellent hospitals a short distance from the church.

Congregation

The congregation is currently between 35-45 worshipers that regularly attend our weekly Sunday Services and 10-15 regularly attend weekly Wednesday night Bible studies. Sunday services are separated into both youth and adult services with nursery provided. Wednesday night Bible studies have classes for adult, teens and youth. In addition, we have Sunday School for adults and youth.

Seminole Christian Fellowship can best be described as multi-cultural congregation, loving, family oriented and open to the working of the Holy Spirit.
