Overview

Weekly attendance at First Spanish Open Bible Church is approximately 120 people. The church building is two stories with parking underneath for approximately 65 cars. It was built in 1989 and can accommodate a total of 700 persons between its first and second levels. It has a baptistry, an office space that has the Pastor's office, secretarial office, file and computer room. It also has a full kitchen and a fellowship hall that can accommodate about 100 people. On its third level it has 5 classrooms with a capacity of approximately 20 persons each.

City of Hialeah

The city of Hialeah has a population of approximately 225,000. The City of Hialeah is ethnically and racially diverse with the majority of its population, over 90%, of Hispanic origin. Because of its Hispanic population, new Hispanic immigrants come to Hialeah to work and grow roots.

The City of Hialeah is minutes away from world-famous South Beach and Miami Beach. Local temperatures vary from the 90s in summer to low 50s in winter.

Top industries are tourism, agriculture, international trade and financial services. Port Miami is the largest cruise terminal in the world and Hialeah is minutes away from Miami International Airport, considered the gateway to the Americas.
